So All Are Welcome

In order for us to welcome others as Christ did, we recognize that caring for our facility matters for our future ministry. As the foundation for a capital campaign planned for spring, we've identified several projects within the Cross Winds building that either require updating or are ready for renovation.

WELCOMING ALL TO THE TABLE – EXTENDING OUR HOSPITALITY

Providing places to gather around the table matters. Jesus spent time eating in people's homes and sharing his life. We have a passion to expand our hospitality opportunities to our church family and our community and these improvements will enable us to do that.

Fellowship Hall Kitchen Expansion

Expanding and upgrading our kitchen to a larger, commercial grade facility will allow us to offer more events for our church community, missional and outreach projects, and host more community events.

- Stove, ovens, hood, warming ovens, microwaves, refrigerator, freezer to accommodate serving large gatherings
- Separate stainless steel food preparation and serving areas
- Hand washing sink, prep sink, dish washing sinks and dishwasher
- Built-in storage / cabinets
- Additional floor space for people working in the kitchen.
- A new storage area in the corner of FH for chairs and tables that can also provide additional built-in serving counter space.

Upgraded Deck

Upgrade the deck on the East side of FH to an enlarged, 15' x 30' deck that will allow for outdoor fellowship with tables and chairs. It also will provide for flexibility for programs such as outdoor worship, concerts, and other community events.

Restroom Upgrades

The restrooms on the main level require accessibility and fixture upgrades. Accessibility upgrades include grab bars and stall doors that swing out in all stalls, clearances and accessories at the right height and location. Aesthetic upgrades to finishes and installation of new fixtures in both restrooms also will be included.

ADA Upgrades

Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) upgrades are required and include rebuilding handrails on the narthex stairs to meet current code, and adding contrasting colored rubber edging to the stair tread nosing for safety. Railings also need to be added to the steps on the lower-level exit sidewalk.

Motorized Window Shades

Mechanical shades on the sanctuary windows will improve the user experience and allow for more control of the room for daytime and evening services and events, and better support filming for online needs.

Sanctuary Projectors

The sanctuary utilizes three projectors; two of which require upgrading and replacing. .

Enhanced Lighting and Audio

Additional lighting of the chancel area will allow for better presentation and enhance our ability to record and preserve services, youth and adult productions and concerts.

Audio Equipment

Producing online worship services requires additional audio equipment to record the diversity of musical groups and creative worship experiences that Cross Winds values. The speaker system in the sanctuary also is in need of upgrades.

WELCOMING ALL TO JOIN US - ENTRYWAY IMPROVEMENTS

Providing safe access to our facility for our church family and community groups to gather is important.

Security Enhancements

Installing a new card reader system will increase security and safety by allowing us to provide key fobs to all users that need access to the building, including outside groups that use our facility. Full control over who and when people are accessing the church's front door will be included with this system. We also will be able to better secure the building at the end of each day.

Installing a camera system for the parking lot and exterior doors will provide a much-needed level of safety for everyone. The current front doors also will be replaced with card access with updates to the auto operator to better align with ADA guidelines..

Interior Vestibule Doors

The simple act of adding a second set of exterior doors interior to the current exterior doors does a number of things for our building. It provides another layer of security. It also provides for better climate control, assist with building maintenance and energy efficiencies.
